AUTHENTICITY OF PIECE – *as supported by documentation*

- 1 = No information provided.
- 2 = Minimal information - non-period source.
- 3 = Some attempt at period style or subject (passably period).
- 4 = Moderate attempt at period style and subject.
- 5 = Fully documented period piece or original in documented period style & subject.

Judges comments:

COMPLEXITY, DIFFICULTY, OR AMBITIOUSNESS OF PIECE

- 1 = Minimal planning required.
- 2 = Piece is brief or simple in form.
- 3 = Piece require some skill & preparation to perform.
- 4 = Piece requires moderate skill & preparation to perform.
- 5 = Piece requires high level of skill & preparation to perform.

Judges comments:

TECHNICAL SKILL - *In tune, in rhythm, elocution, diction, projection, volume, harmony, blending, execution, etc.*

- 1 = Minimal skill displayed in performance.
- 2 = Some skill displayed in performance.
- 3 = Moderate skill displayed in performance.
- 4 = Very good skill displayed in performance.
- 5 = Exceptional skill displayed in performance.

Judges comments:

PRESENTATION, INTERPRETATION, OVERALL IMPRESSION - *movement, bearing, flourishes, manner, creativity, ornamentation, introduction, grooming, appropriate costumes / props*

- 1 = Minimal effect on audience (polite response only).
- 2 = Little effect on audience (people are listening or watching).
- 3 = Moderate effect on audience (people are reacting to performance).
- 4 = Moderate effect on audience (people are reasonably engaged).
- 5 = Exceptional effect on audience (people are completely engaged).
